SCHEDULED FOR MONDAY MAY 1, 2017

"COMPUTERS, HARD DRIVES, MONITORS, PERSONAL ELECTRONICS, TELEVISIONS, ETC."
WILL NOT BE PICKED UP THIS YEAR.

The Cattaraugus County Transfer Station in Machias will accept these items, free of charge, during normal operating hours Tuesday & Wednesday 9:30 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. and Saturday 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Note: There is a limit of 1 per day for a CRT TV or Monitor

"NO TIRES WILL BE PICKED UP THIS YEAR"

The Cattaraugus County Transfer Station in Machias will accept a maximum of four (4) car tires per licensed driver at no charge on the following date: Saturday, 04/29/17 from 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Guidelines:

1 One pick up - Starting Monday May 1, 2017

2 Streets will be COVERED ONCE.

3 Ten item limit per household (Equal to 10 trash bags).

4 Refuse/Trash is to be within 5 feet of curbside.

5 Refuse/Trash shall include, but not be limited to, refrigerators, freezers, washers, dryers, furniture, cans, bottles, batteries, etc.

6 NO household garbage, oil, building material, concrete, blacktop, stone, dirt, dead animals, fecal matter.

7 HAZARDOUS WASTE OF ANY TYPE, WILL NOT BE TAKEN.

Cattaraugus County DPW is planning a Hazardous Waste Disposal Day in Little Valley by Appointment Only, watch for notices in September for the date. Please call Kathy at 716-938-2441 to schedule.

8 NO brush or tree trimmings.

9 Each item shall not weigh more than 80 pounds.

10 Trash pick-up will be for the entire Town of Yorkshire, but excluding the Village of Delevan.

11 TRASH MUST BE AT THE ROAD SIDE BY 6 A.M MAY 1

but do not place the trash at the roadside before Saturday, April 29

12 "ALL REGULATIONS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED THIS YEAR"
