Chris Lexer – Highway – The town highway has been plowing and sanding as needed and maintaining the equipment. The salt and sand mixture to melt roads off quicker this year. Also trying to save on quantity cost and clean up. We have been adjusting the ratio of salt and sand to help melt off the roads faster. In addition anything we put on the road such as sand has to be swept up and picked up in the spring. The salt does not require to be picked up in the spring. Trying to come up with a sand / salt mixture that makes our roads safer. The salt shed project will be started in April/May would like to fill it

when it is done. Will be looking into replacing the full time employee that retired, a CDL license is required. Will be advertising for this soon. CHIPS funding information is starting to come down, will keep the board updated.
